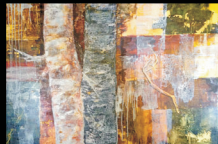
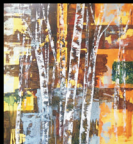
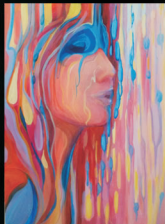


Deepti Nair

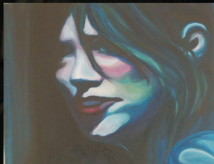
